Notes:

- (1) "General Studies" students are reported as a separate category, but when quoting enrollment by college, "General Studies" should be included in the College of Arts & Sciences.
- (2) The total headcount agrees with the Student Data Course File (SDCF). "Lower" and "Upper" on the SDCF refer to the division to which the student has been admitted, not the student classification and not necessarily the course level.
- (3) Students with multiple majors/minors have been entered in the major listed first on the student record. This eliminates the problem of headcount duplication.
- (4) Fall 2001 marked the beginning of the Interdisciplinary Information Technology Program (CIP 11.1095,11.0103). As the name implies, the students' headcounts are spread out across disciplines and colleges. Previously this was spread throughout the colleges but the control changed to Arts & Sciences in Fall 2003. However, the headcounts, for the purposes of this report, will be left in the various colleges.
- (5) In Summer 2003, Universities converted to CIP 2000.
- (6) UWF's enrollment approached 10,000 at the beginning of Fall 2004. In September, the area was hit by Hurricane Ivan, so withdrawal rates were much higher than normal.
